

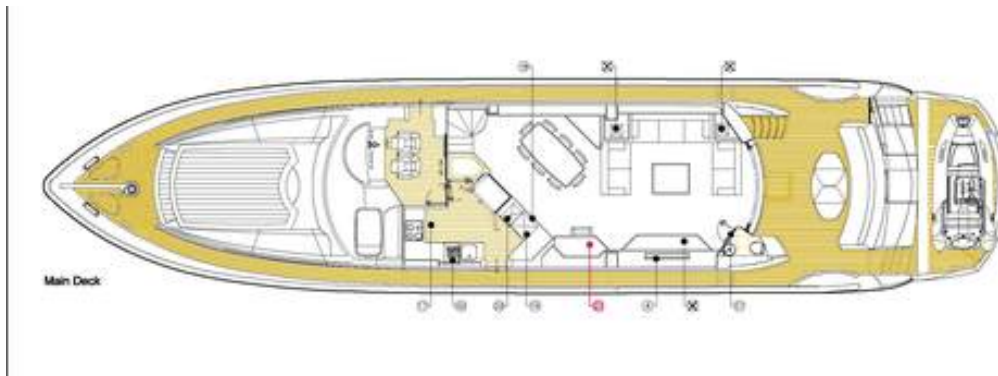

■ Entering into this beautiful 90 Yacht from the informal aft seating area you arrive in a spacious interior completed in a stunning high gloss cherry, the elegant lounge area flows into a formal dining area with seating for 8. Finished with Black Galaxy granite the galley has an array of high spec intergrated appliances suitable for all your culinary needs. Also on this level is the impressive state of the art helm room. Going downstairs to the lower level you find the grand master suite at the stern with window sofa, large walk in wardrobe and spacious en-suite comprising of twin sinks, WC, Bidet and walk in wet room style shower. Forward of this are two well appointed twin berths with en-suites, leading through to the bow of the boat where an ample VIP stateroom, accommodated with walk in wardrobe and stylish en-suite.
